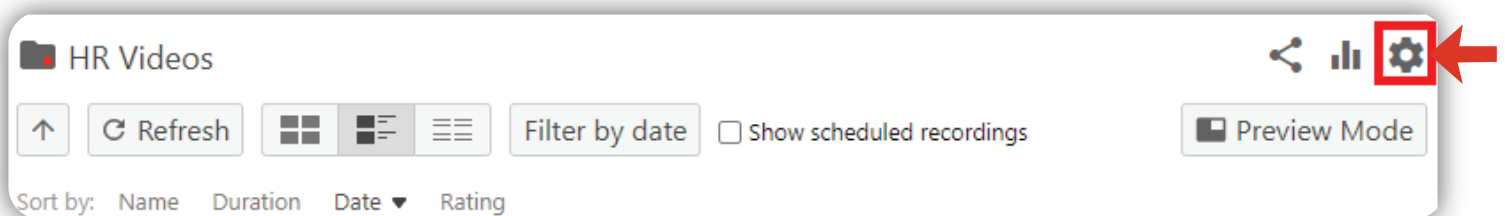


HOW TO USE MULTIPLE LANGUAGE ASR CAPTIONING

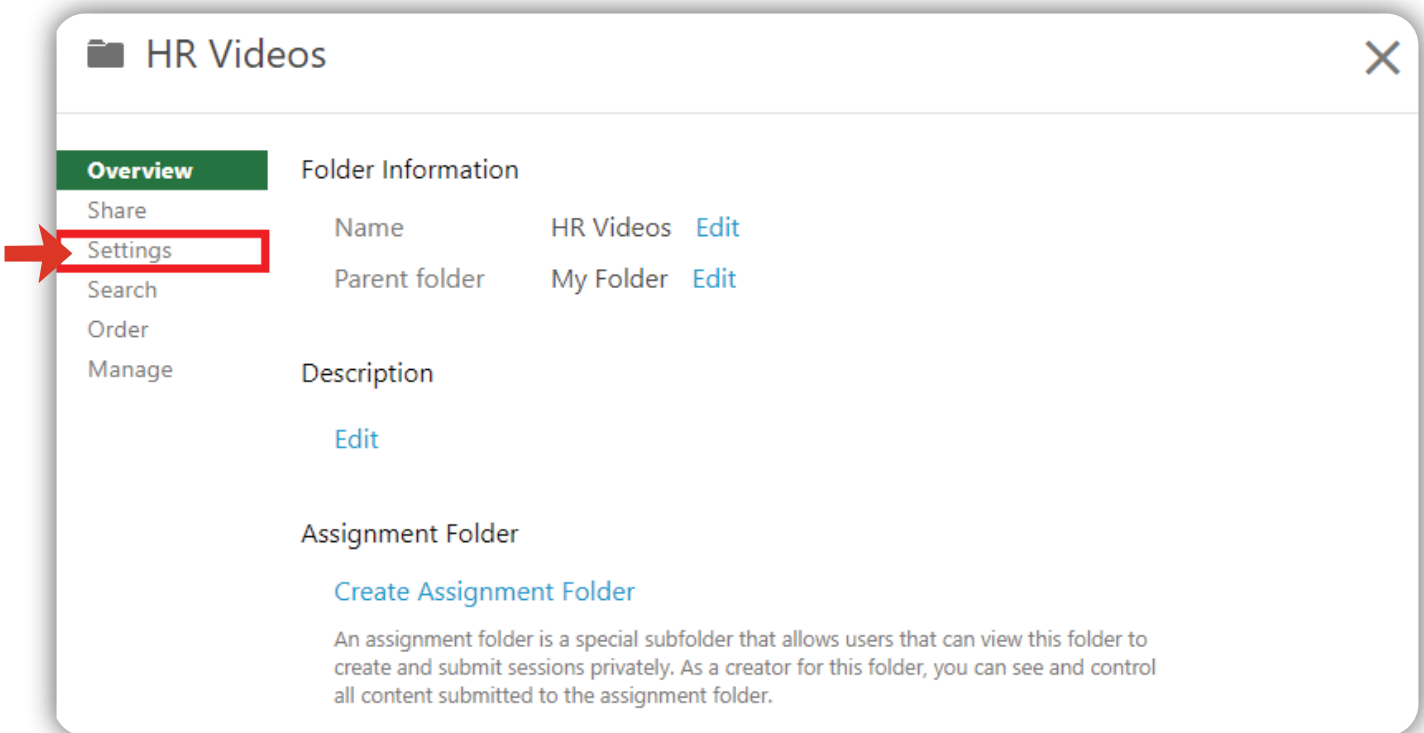
In this article, you will learn how you can change the Automatic Speech Recognition (ASR) captioning language from your Panopto site's default language to the language of your choice for a folder in Panopto. **Note:** This feature does not translate videos via captioning. Only one language may be applied per folder. Currently, these steps allow you to automatically produce ASR captions in the folder's language for new content only but not for content moved or copied from another folder. Panopto is working on an update to this feature to allow users to reprocess their own existing content.

Changing the default language on a folder

1. In the upper right-hand corner of the folder for which you'd like to change the ASR captioning language, selecting the **Settings** icon.



2. The Settings module for the folder will open to the Overview tab. Select the **Settings** tab from the left-hand navigation.



3. On the Settings tab, select the dropdown menu located under the **Content Language** section.

4. The following language options are available for you to choose from: English (United States), Español (Mexico), Español (España), German, French, Italian, etc.

5. After you've selected the language, and exited the Settings module, any video in the folder that has automatic captioning will appear with the ASR captioning language selected.

Note: The ASR language will change for all new sessions that are added to the folder but not for sessions already in the folder or sessions moved from another folder.
