ACT On Campus Testing in Edinburg

Exam Fee: **\$90**

The ACT On Campus is an institution exam offered to prospective UTRGV students as a college entrance exam only. You must have applied or be enrolled at UTRGV.

Institutional TOEFL

Exam Fee: **\$50**

The TOEFL ITP measures the English-language proficiency of individuals who are non-native speakers of English. TOEFL ITP test scores are to be used only by the institution that administers the test.

What to bring on test date:

Bring one valid, unexpired photo identification (e.g., driver's license, school ID, passport) You will not be permitted to test without a valid photo ID.

If you do not have a current official photo ID please bring the ACT Student Identification Form completed by a school official or notary public

Approved calculator. Please visit act.org to see a list of approved calculators.

Score Reports:

When the test taker has completed the test, the unofficial score will be provided. Scores are sent to UTRGV; Usually available same day.

Retest Policy: Examinee must wait 60 days to retake

What to bring on test date:

All test takers are required to present a valid and acceptable identification (ID). You will not be permitted to test without a valid ID.

Each ID must:

Be an original document; photocopies are not accepted

Be valid; expired documents are not acceptable.

Include the test taker's full name, matching exactly the name used to register.

Include a recent photograph that clearly matches the test taker's appearance.

Include the test takers signature (the name and signature on the ID document must match)

Score Reports:

When the test taker has completed the test, the unofficial score will be displayed. Scores are sent to UTRGV; Usually available same day.

ACT Identification policy

Only the following forms of identification are acceptable. If it is not on this list, it is not acceptable, and you will not be admitted to test.

•Current official photo ID - Must be an original, current (valid) ID issued by a city/state/federal government agency or your school. Note: School ID must be in hard plastic card format. Paper or electronic formats are NOT acceptable. Your first and last names must match the ticket. The photo must be clearly recognizable as you.

or

•ACT Student Identification Letter with Photo - You MUST present this ACT Student Identification Letter with Photo if you do not have a current official photo ID as described above. It must be completed by a school official or notary public; neither may be a relative. All items must be completed.
