ONLINE REGISTRATION: Visit www.utrgv.edu/p16/testing to register. Click on *Register for an Exam* Click on the location where you would like to test. Look for TCFP Correspondence and select desired date and time. Click "Add to Cart". Enter modifier information (First Name, Last Name, Email address, and Phone number) at the bottom of the page and press continue. When you are done press "Checkout" button. *If this is your first time registering for an exam with P16 Outreach & Testing Services, you will have to create an account or check out as a guest.*

2. REPORTING TIME: Report to the exam site at least 10 minutes before your testing time. **Late examinees will not be allowed to test after the scheduled testing time passes and exam fees will not be refunded.**

3. IDENTIFICATION: Bring a valid (non expired) PHOTO ID, preferably a driver's license, recent school ID, or passport. Examinees will not be admitted without a proper PHOTO ID—expired ID's are not acceptable.

4. SCORES: Available 24 hours from testing through your *Individual Online FIDO* account.

5. REFUND POLICY: All exam fees are non-refundable and cannot be transferred.

6. RETEST POLICY: Retests are allowed within 180 days from the first attempt. After 180 days, examinees must re-train in the discipline they are seeking certification.
