ACT Identification policy

Only the following forms of identification are acceptable. If it is not on this list, it is not acceptable, and you will not be admitted to test.

•Current official photo ID - Must be an original, current (valid) ID issued by a city/state/ federal government agency or your school. Note: School ID must be in hard plastic card format. Paper or electronic formats are NOT acceptable. Your first and last names must match the ticket. The photo must be clearly recognizable as you.

•ACT Student Identification Letter with Photo - You MUST present this ACT Student Identification Letter with Photo if you do not have a current official photo ID as described above. It must be completed by a school official or notary public; neither may be a relative. All items must be completed.
