

FOOTBALL GAME DAY RIDER RULES

It's game day! To help make the Vaquero Football experience enjoyable for everyone, please remember these simple rules when you ride on our buses.

- Priority bus boarding is for seniors and persons with disabilities. If a passenger in a wheelchair is being boarded, please refrain from sitting in the seats at the very back of the bus, as that area will be used to secure the wheelchair.
- Please form an orderly line at bus stops. If people are waiting ahead of you, do not cut in front of them.
- Please board vehicles in the order in which they are parked. Our goal is to fill up the first vehicle parked at a stop completely before boarding the second vehicle, and so on. The second and subsequent vehicles will not open their doors or allow people on board until the first vehicle is completely filled with passengers.
- If a bus is equipped with seat belts, we require that you wear them.
- You must remain seated while the vehicle is in motion. Only if a bus is equipped with handrails and stanchions can a passenger ride while standing.
- Be considerate of others by refraining from making loud noises or causing disruptions of any kind.
- Foul language, obscenities, bad words, or threats against drivers or others are not allowed. Police will be called if the driver or any other passengers feel threatened in any way.
- Please do not eat on the vehicle. Drinks only from containers with spill-proof lids are allowed. If you should happen to spill something, please clean it up immediately.
- Alcohol is not allowed to be consumed on the bus. We will ask you to leave behind any open alcohol containers before boarding.
- Please do not leave trash on the vehicle. If you have trash, take it with you when you exit. If you make a mess, clean it up.
- For passenger safety, drivers are prohibited from opening bus doors once it departs from the designated stop.
- Drivers cannot make unauthorized stops.
- Take care of your belongings. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. All items left on the bus will be given to the Police Department. Anything not accepted by them will be immediately discarded.
- Be considerate when bringing items on the vehicle—there is a limited amount of space.
- Except as allowed by University policy, weapons, tobacco, and vaping are not allowed on the vehicles.

If you violate any rider rule, the driver will ask you to stop your behavior immediately. If you do not stop, the driver will ask you to exit the vehicle. If you refuse to exit, Police will be called. It is our responsibility to ensure that the riding environment is safe and that passengers do not experience any disruption in their experience at any time. We reserve the right to call Police and remove anyone from our vehicles who poses, in our judgment, a significant safety or security concern.
