ETIQUETTE

Remember these simple regulations and tips to maintain a parking and transportation environment that is convenient and safe for everyone.

- All vehicles parked on campus must have a valid parking permit, which is now entirely digital and connected to your license plate.
- Here's How It Works
 - Go to utrgv.edu/myparking
 - Register up to 2 vehicles per permit
 - Choose your preferred parking zone
 - Pay for your permit (zone-based)
- Only one vehicle is allowed on campus at a time.
- Pay attention to zones: your permit indicates what zone you may park within.
- Penalties for violations of regulations include parking fines, impoundment of vehicles, and late fees for nonpayment.
- Be considerate: Don't park along a red fire lane, in a space marked solely for people with disabilities, or anywhere else where parking is clearly prohibited.
- Make sure to become familiar with our rules and regulations - they're on our website: utrgv.edu/parking.

- Can't find parking near your destination? Park remotely then ride on a VOLT cart. To view campus bus routes, scan the QR code on the back or visit us at: utrgv.edu/transportation.

Remember these simple regulations and tips to maintain a parking and transportation environment that is convenient and safe for everyone.

- The **Vaquero Express** is UTRGV's campus bus system. Bus routes operate both within the Brownsville and Edinburg campuses (**VOLT**) and between them (**Campus Connector**).
- Service on any Vaquero Express route is **FREE**.
- Catch the bus at a designated location — they are marked with a bus stop sign.
- Service is based on a first-come, first-served basis. Because all buses have a maximum capacity, we encourage all passengers riding the Campus Connector to arrive at the bus stop 10 to 15 minutes early.
- We have partnerships with **B Metro** in Brownsville and **Valley Metro** throughout the Valley to provide free trips on their systems with a valid UTRGV ID. **RGV Metro Express's Orange Line** also provides campus-to-campus service. Check out the route map here: lrgvdc.org/valleymetro.html
- If you can't find nearby parking to get to your destination, park in a remote lot and then take **VOLT**. There's no need to walk a long distance.
