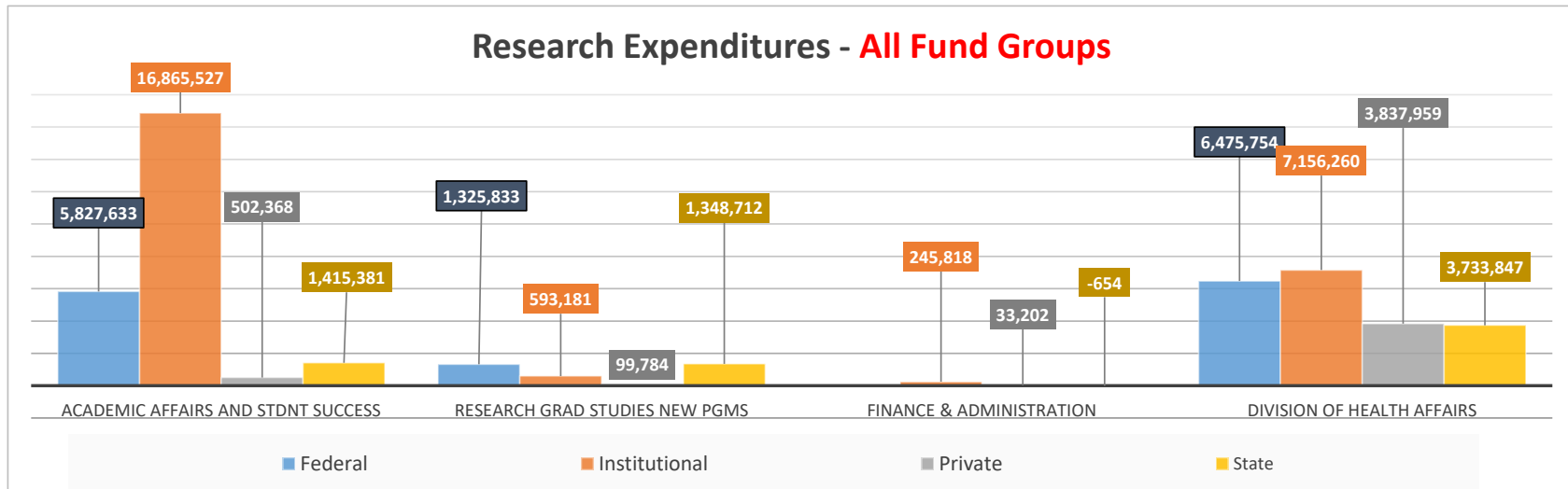

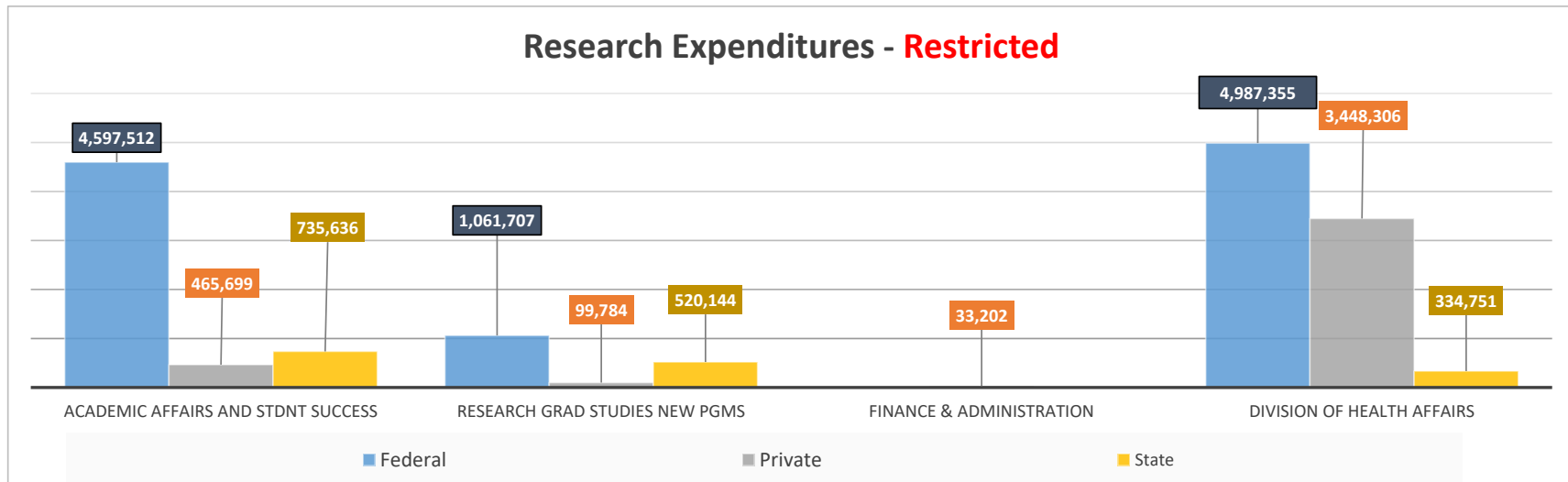
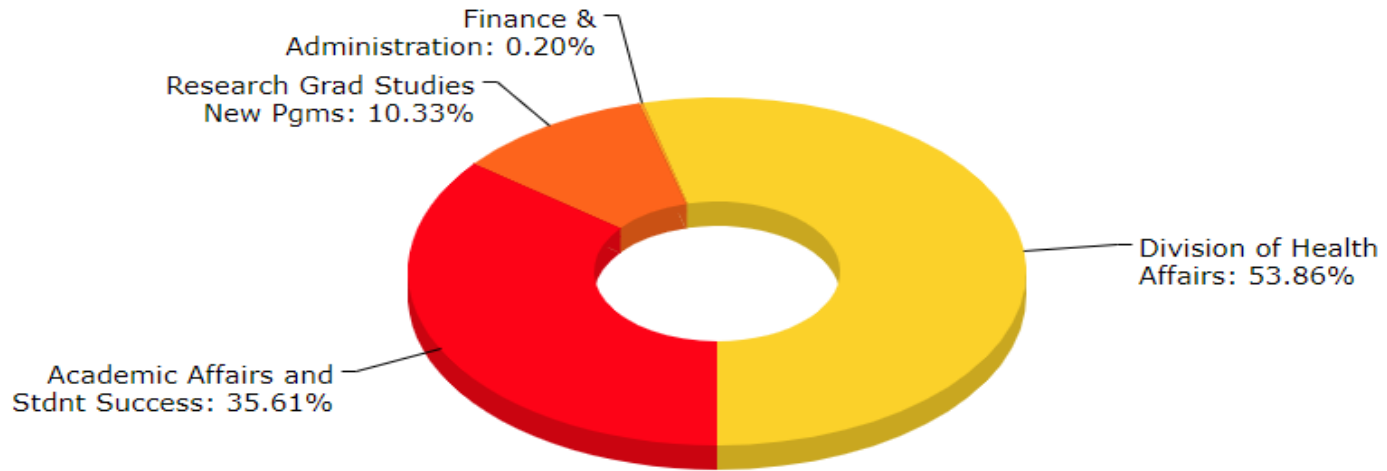
# RESEARCH EXPENDITURES - All Fund Groups

Year-to-Date as of August 31, 2019



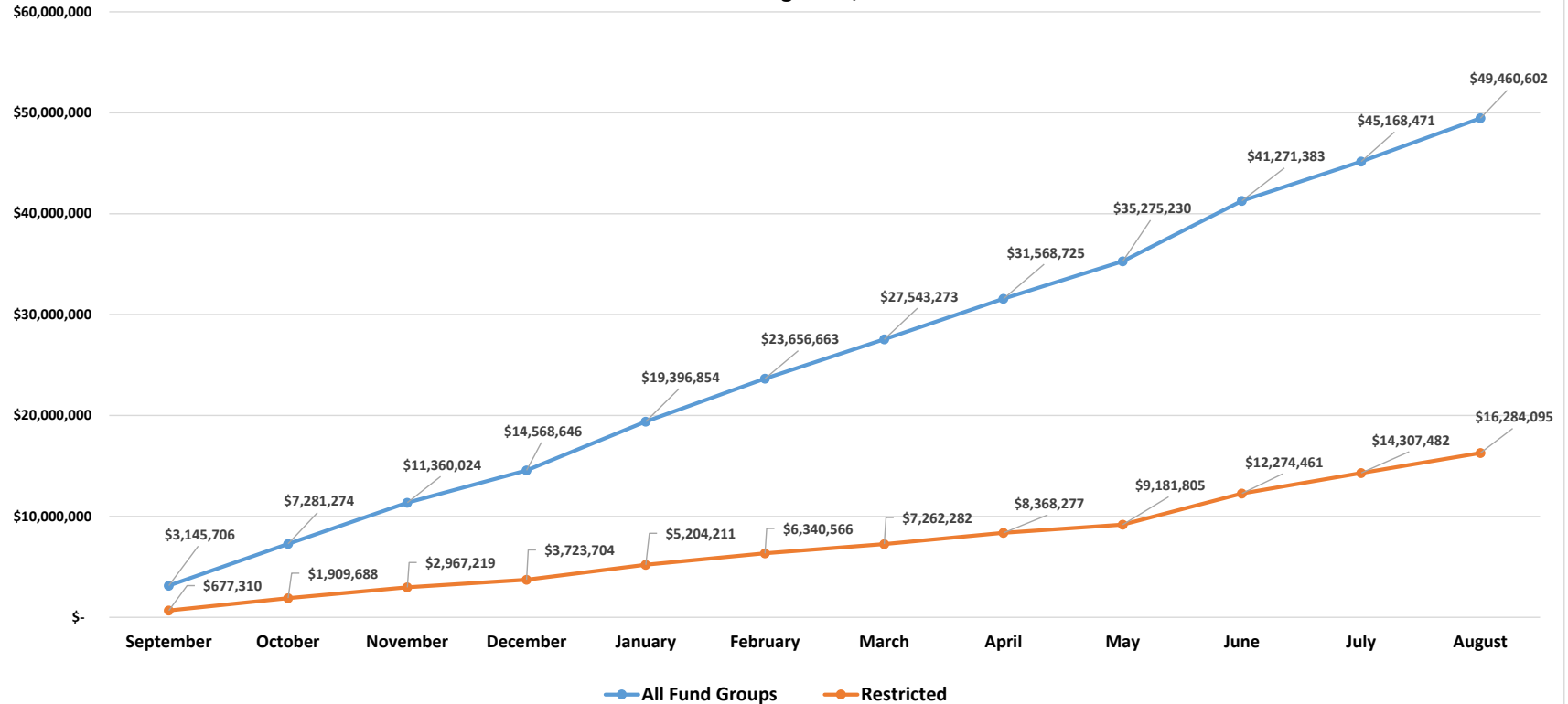
# RESEARCH EXPENDITURES - Restricted

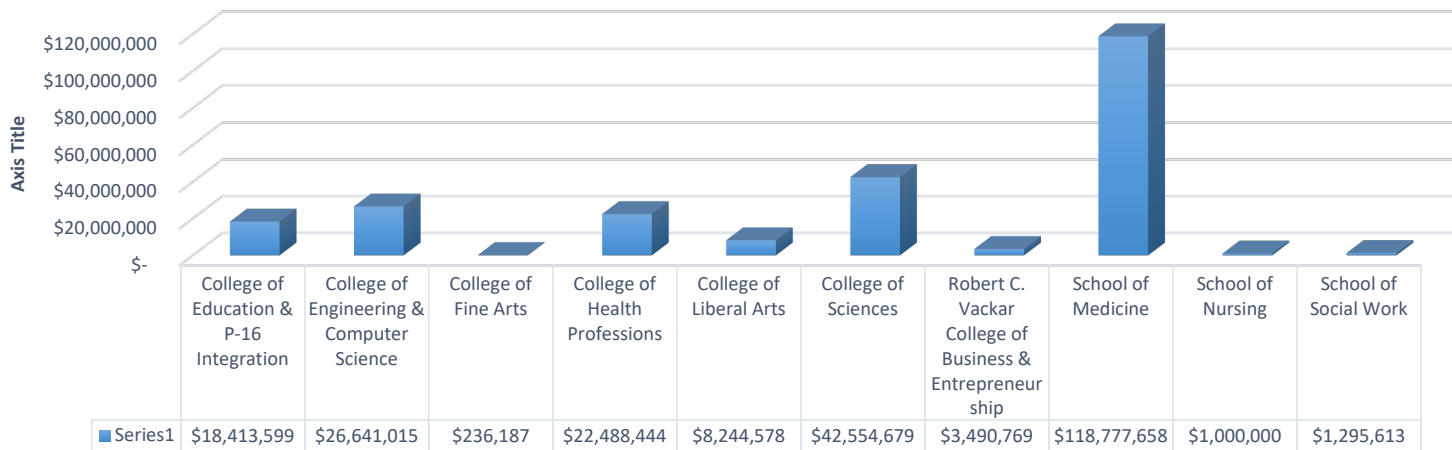

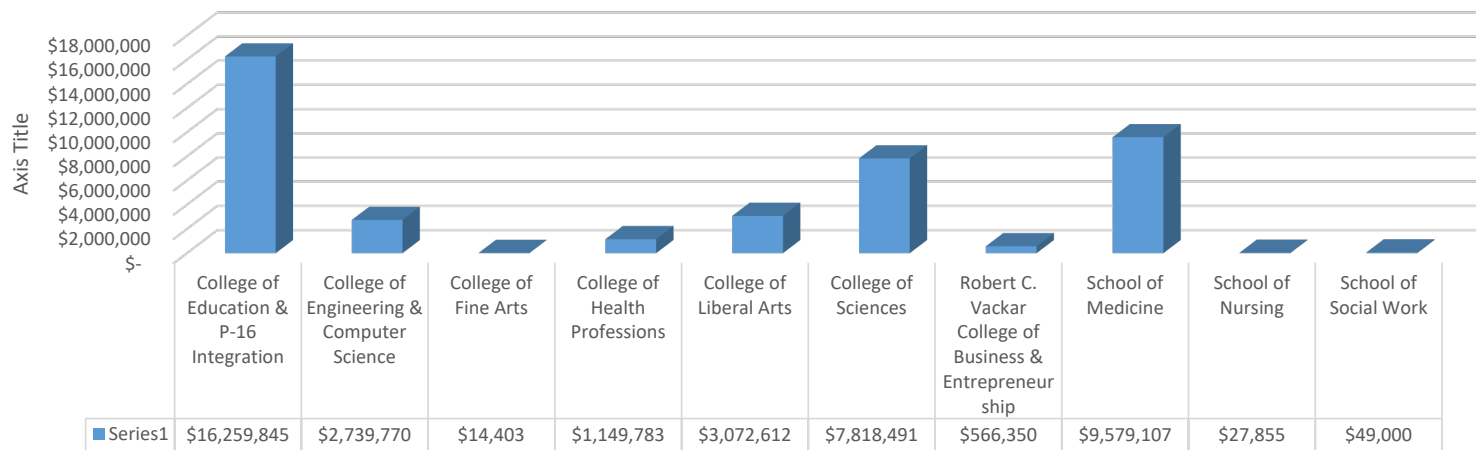
