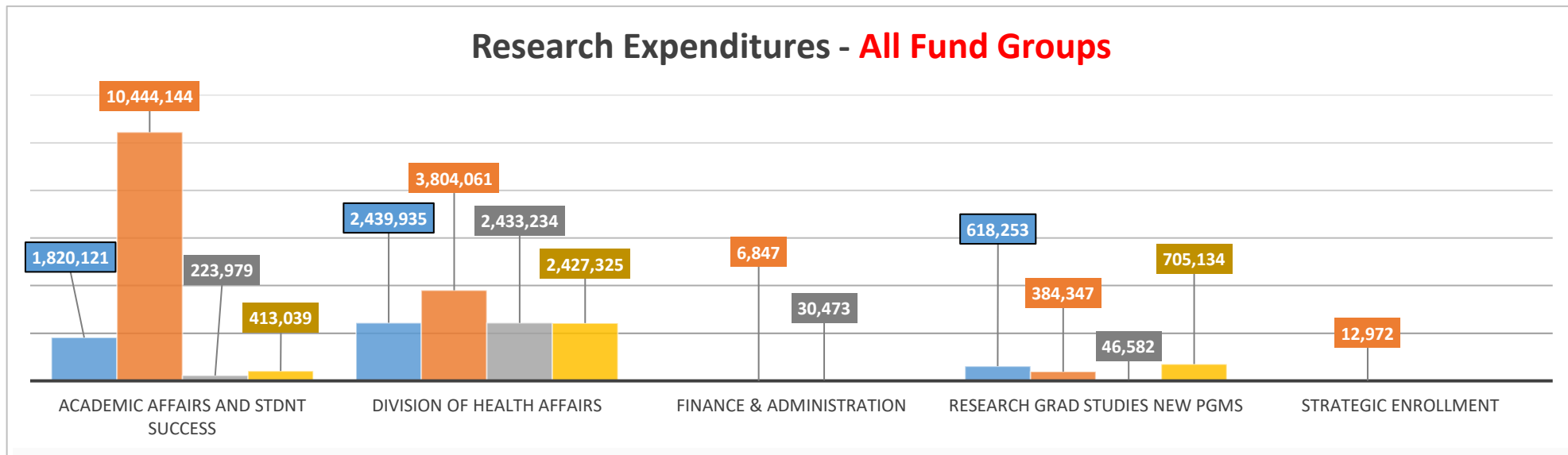

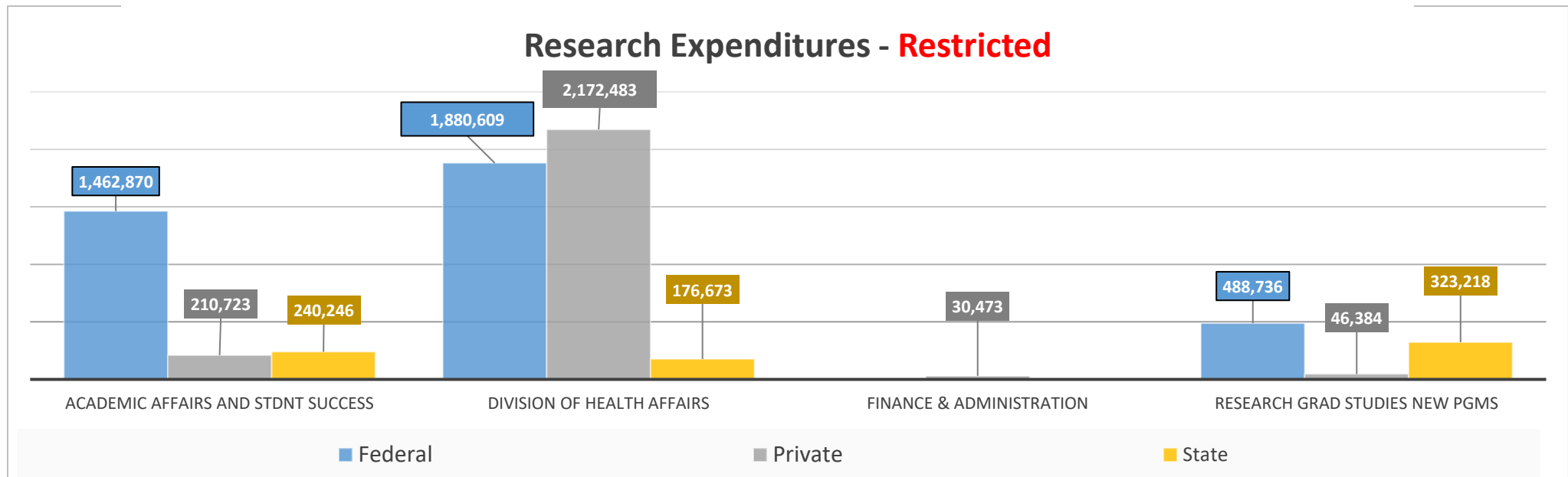

Research Expenditures - All Fund Groups Year-to-Date as of February 29, 2020

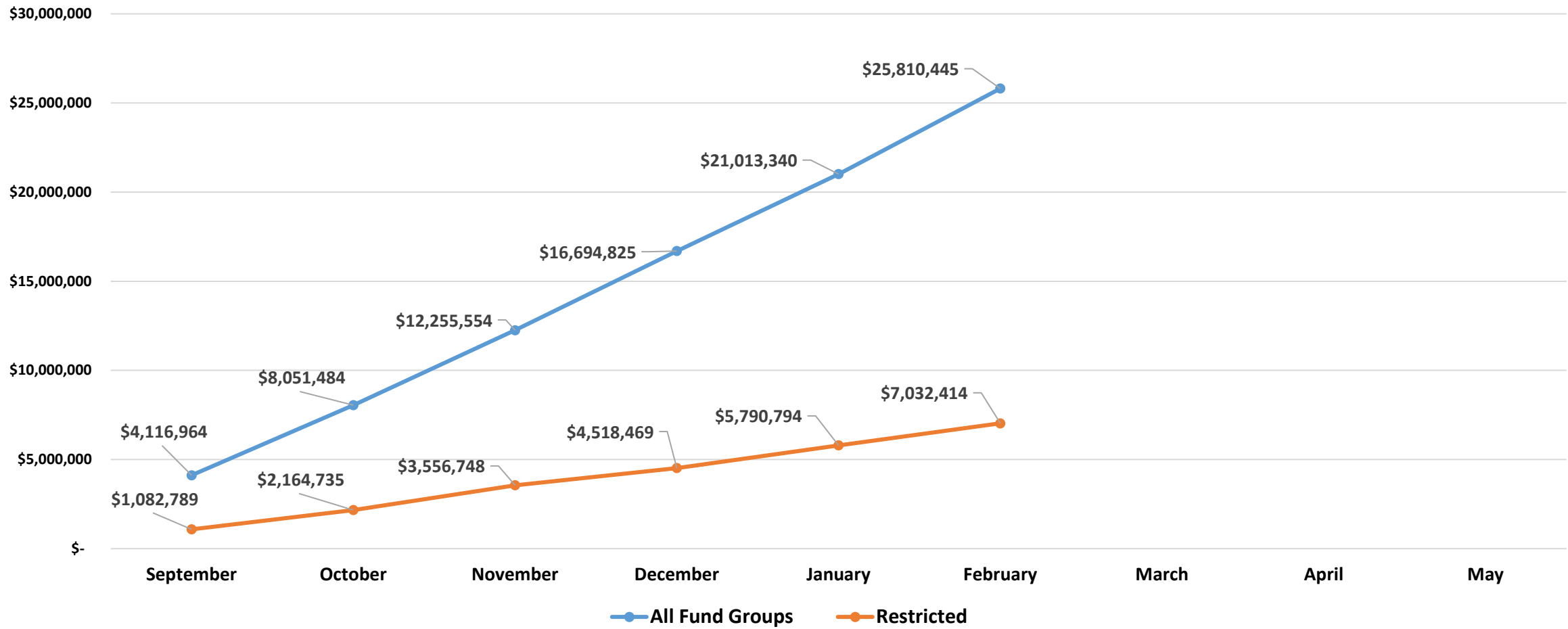


Research Expenditures - Restricted Year-to-Date as of February 29, 2020

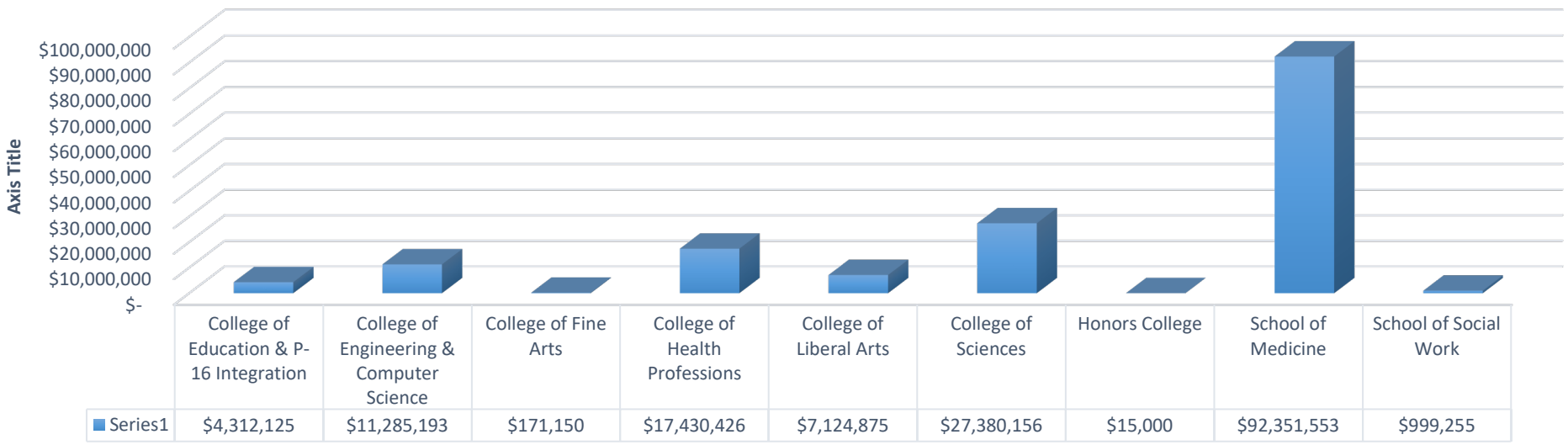

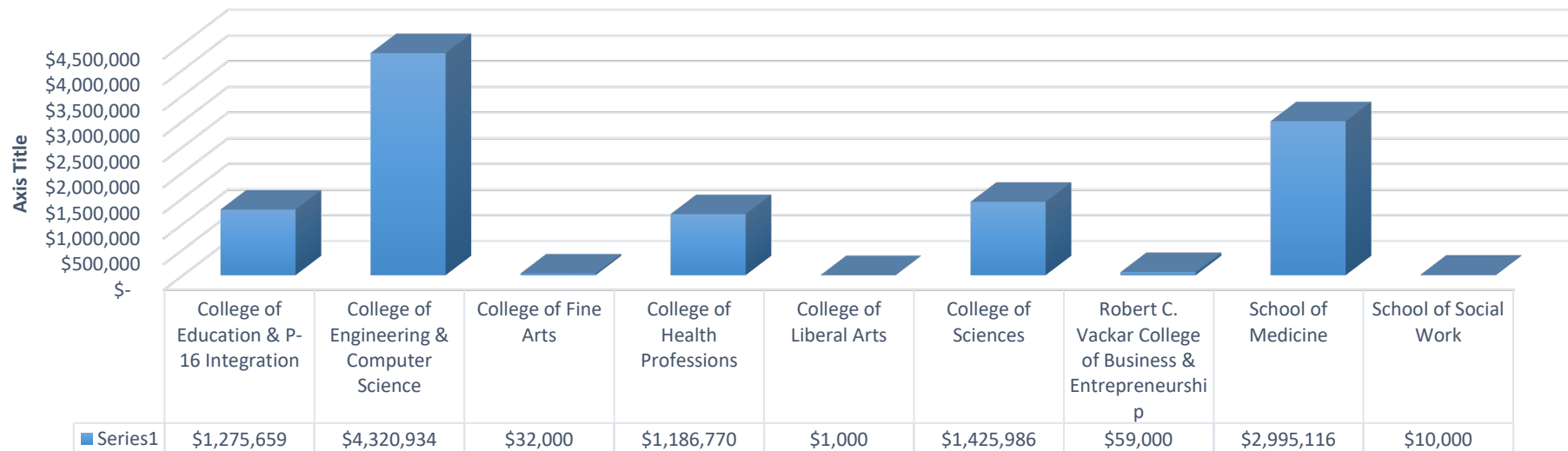
