





At UMN we are unlikely to release patented software open source. This is primarily because we see a patent as an investment in the power to

exclude, open sourcing counters that investment.

GPL v3.0 & Apache v2.0:
GPL v3.0 & Apache v2.0 now have a patent clause that provides a royalty free, non-exclusive patent license to the licensee if contributed source infringes.
