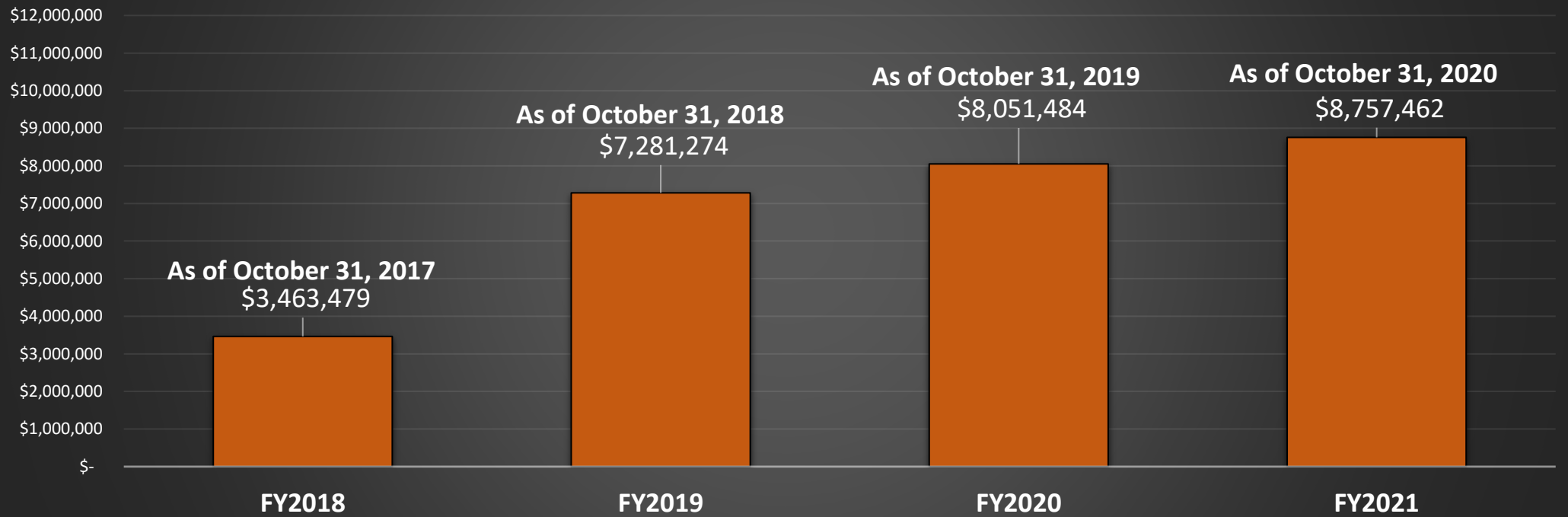

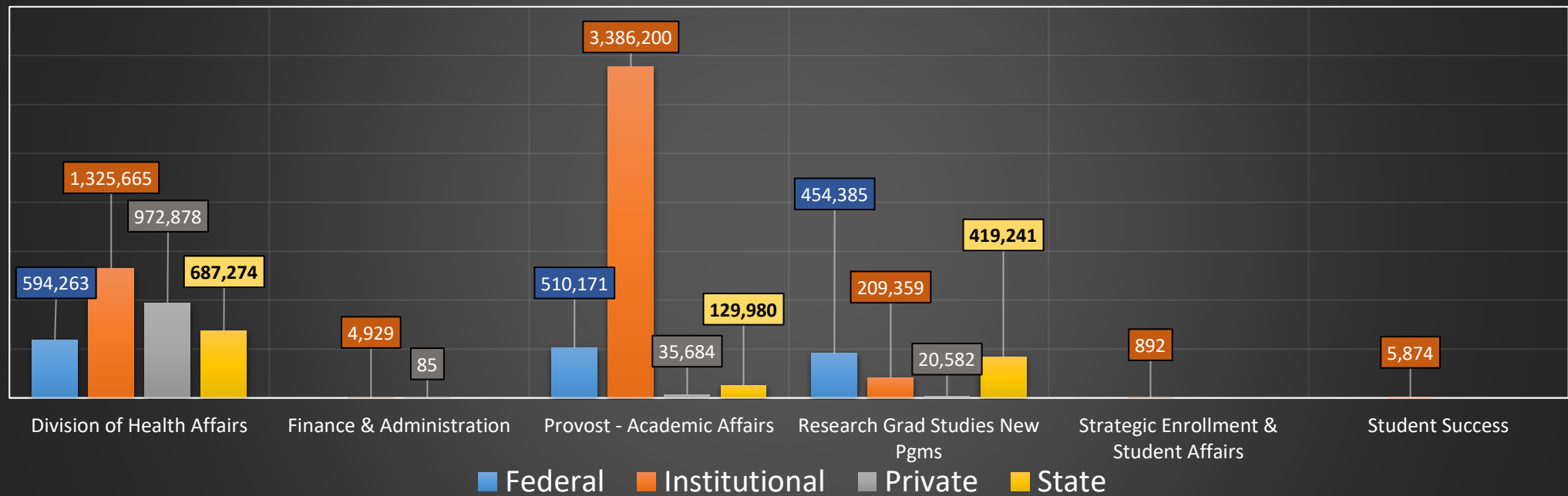

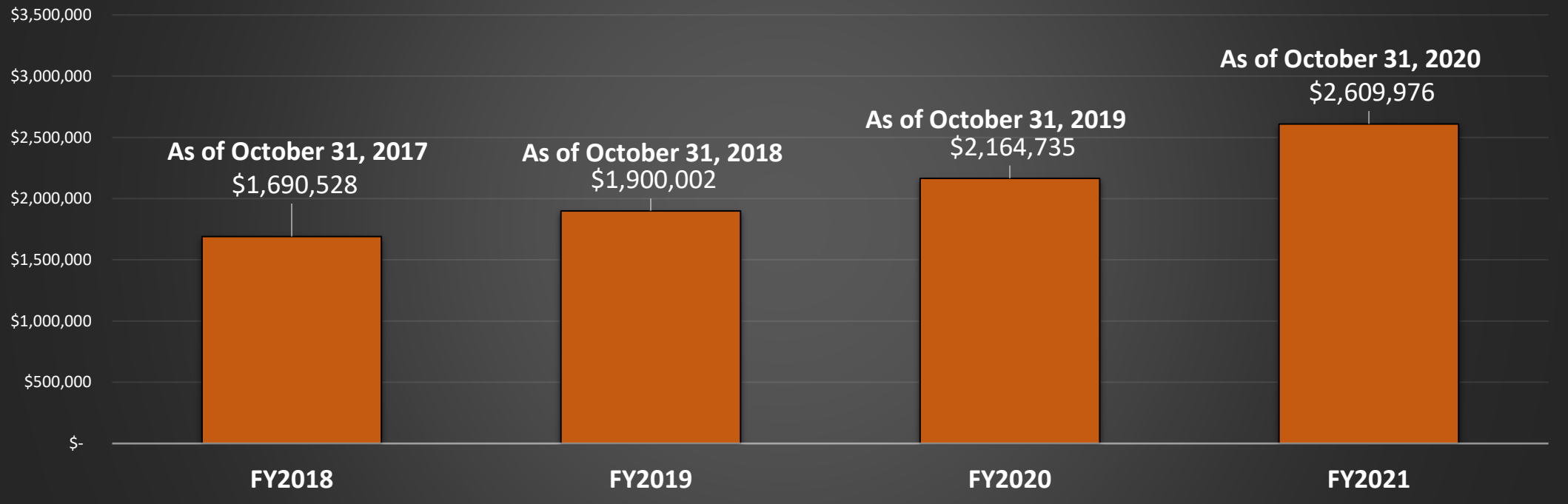
Research Expenditures - All Fund Groups - By Fiscal Year



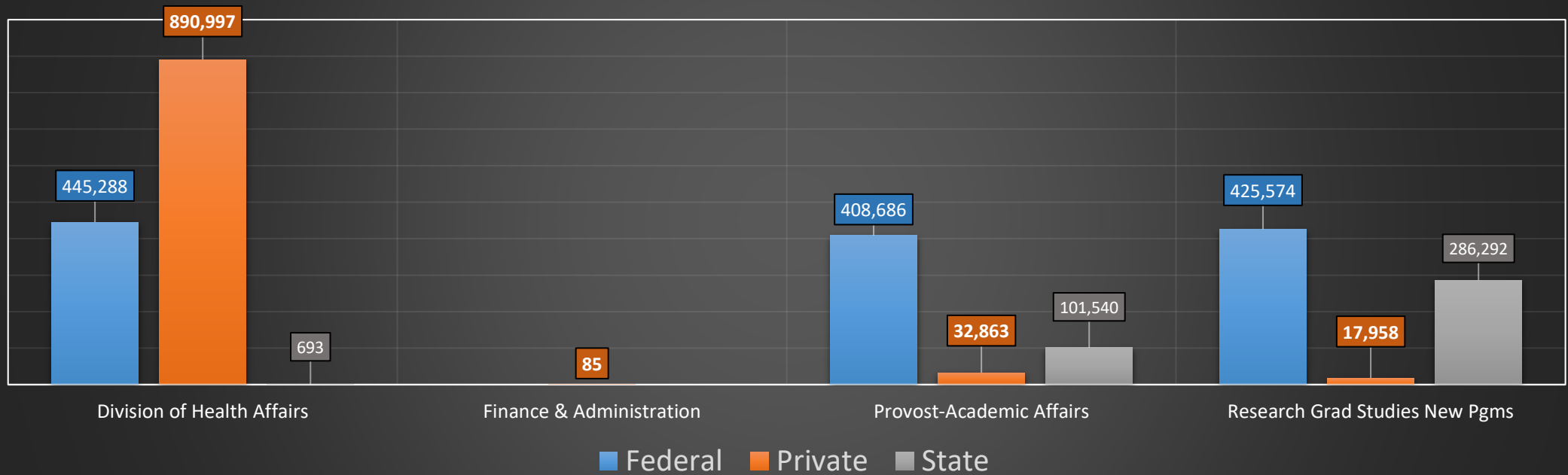
Research Expenditures - All Fund Groups - By Division



Research Expenditures - **Restricted** - By Fiscal Year



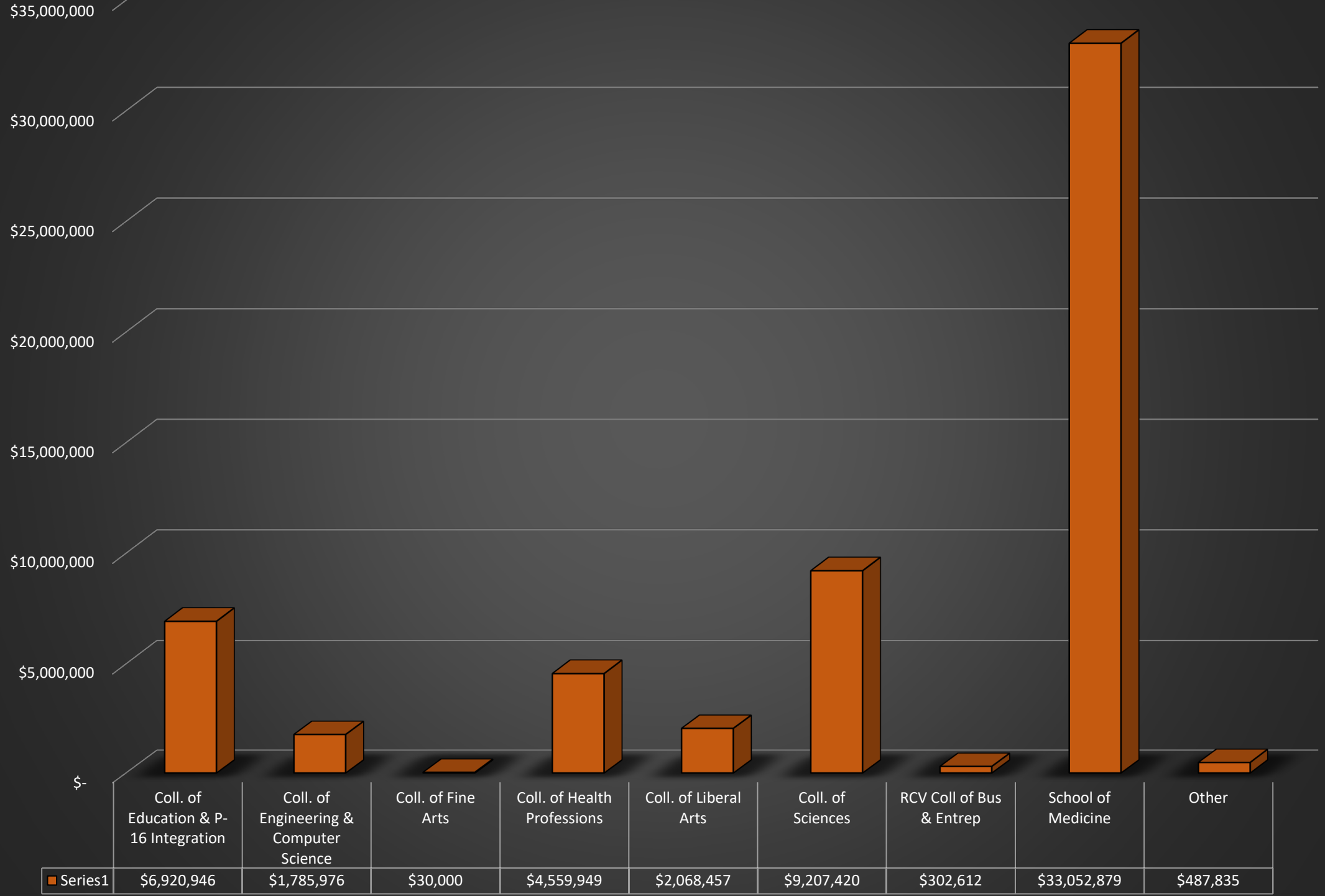

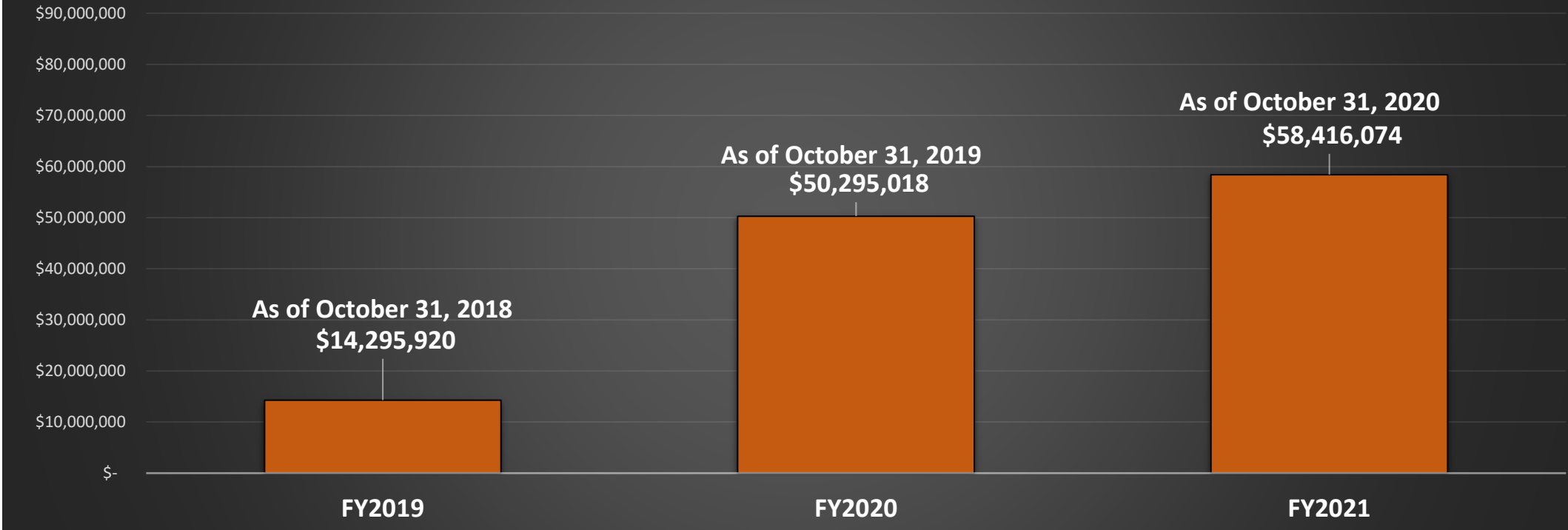

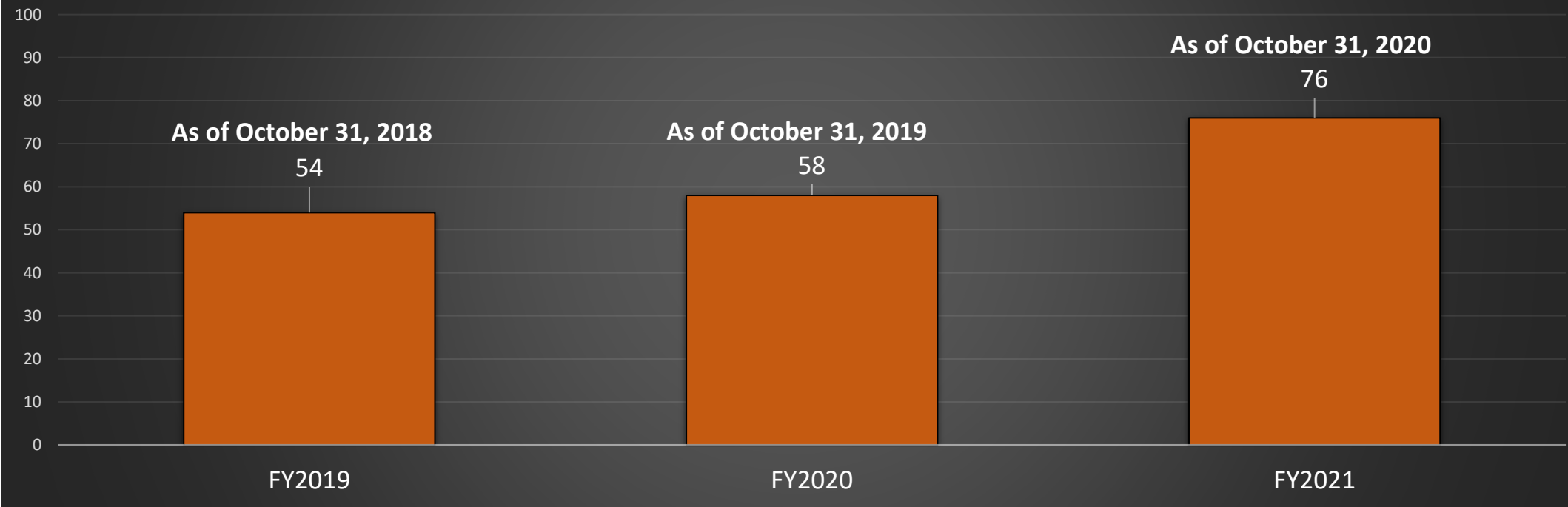
Proposal Submission - Funds Requested By College & Schools

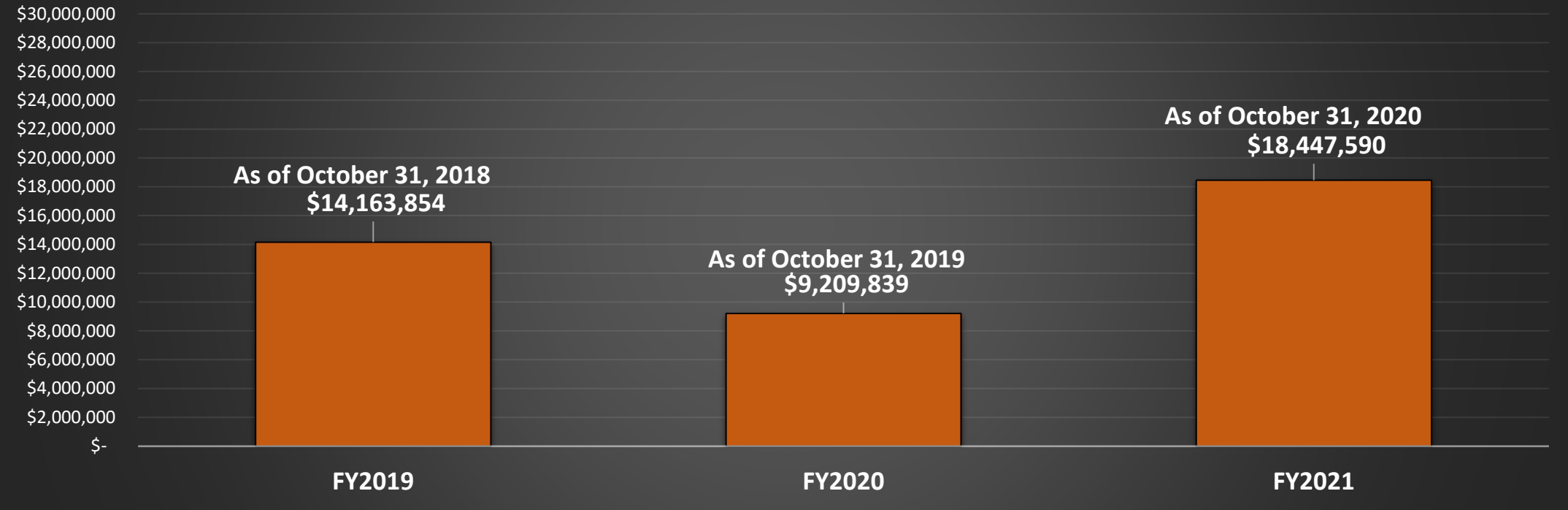

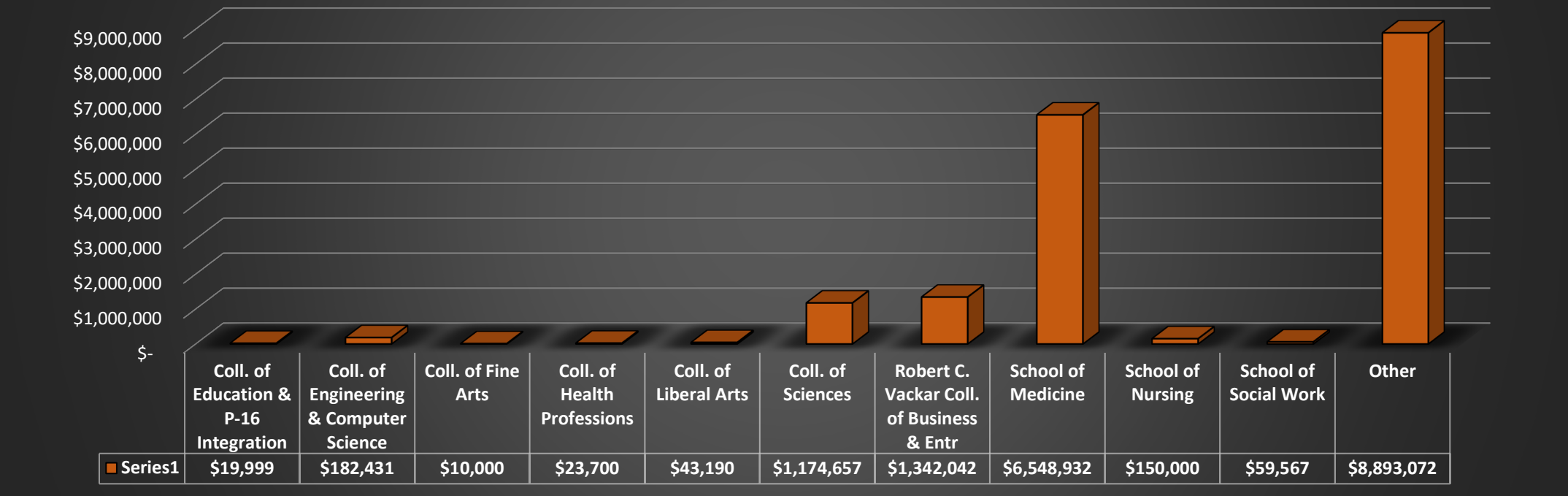
