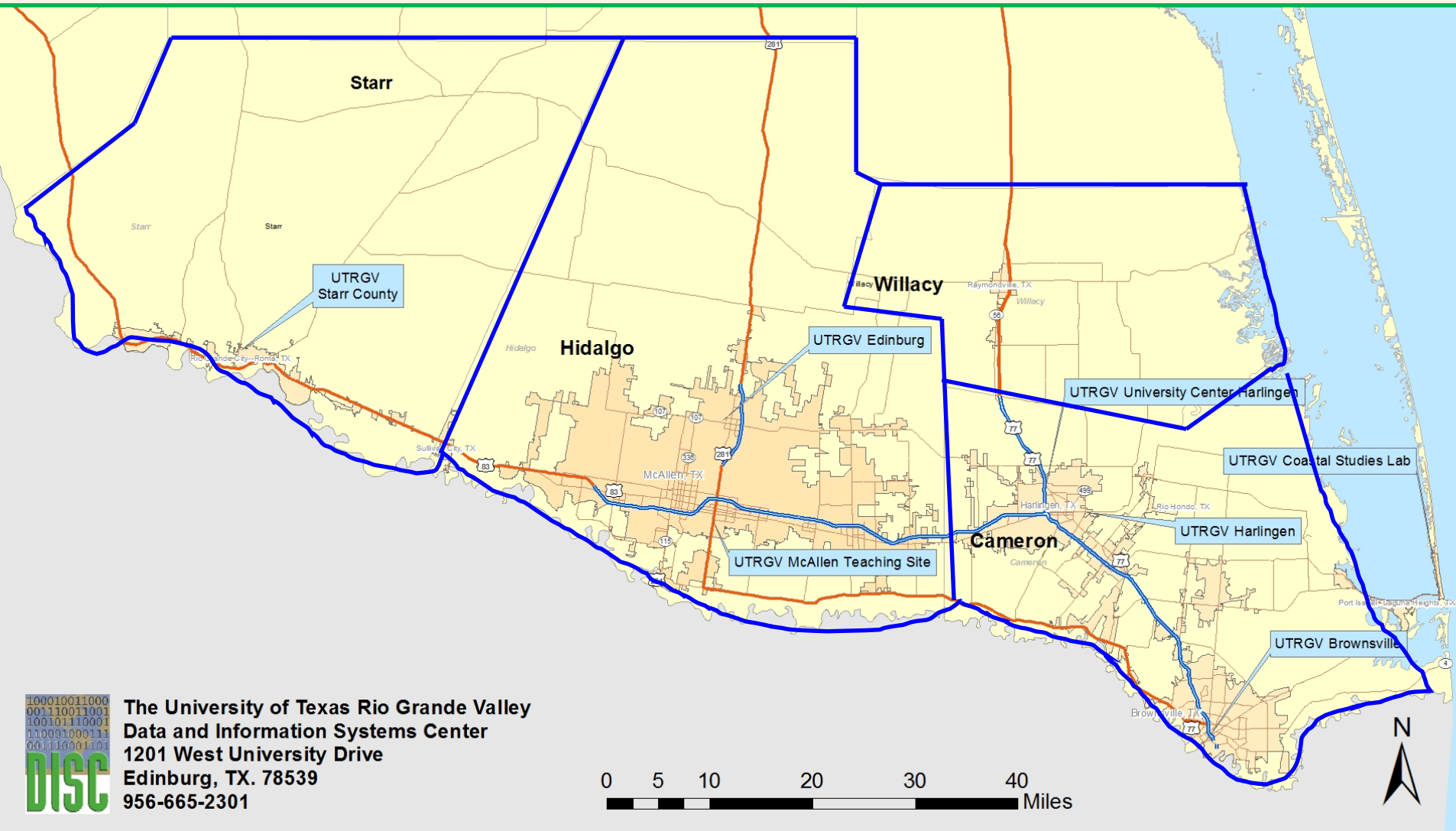


# UTRGV Purpose



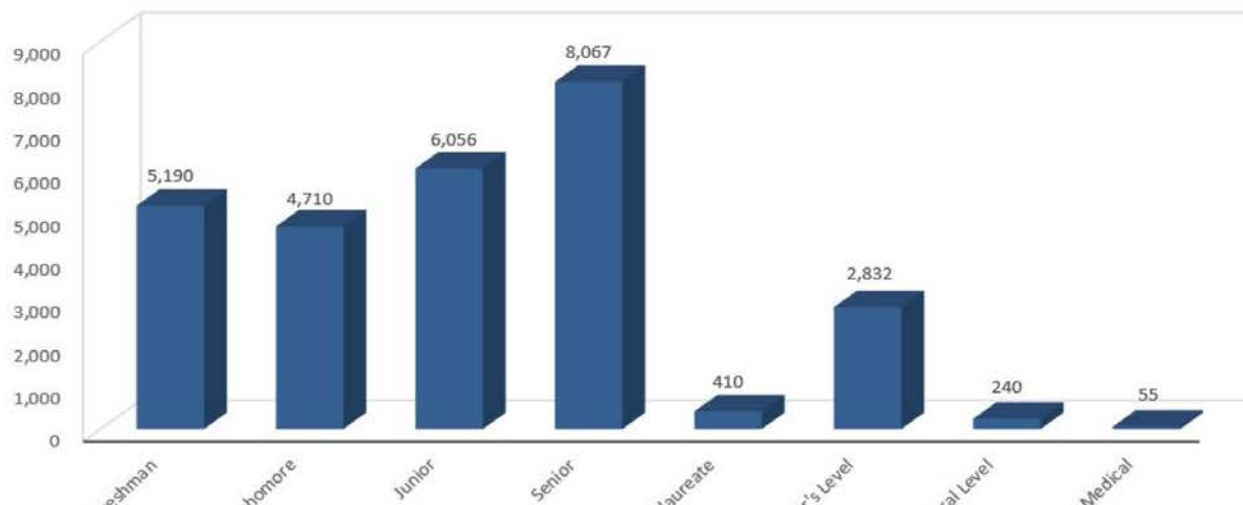
