

UTRGV's Tuition & Mandatory Fees in Perspective – Fall 2019

Data from the Integrated Fiscal Reporting System (IFRS) was used to look at UTRGV's Tuition & Mandatory Fees (T&F) as compared to other 4-yr public universities in Texas and within the UT System.

- UTRGV's T&F of \$3,853 for 15 resident undergraduate hours in Fall 2019 makes it the 2nd most affordable 4-year public university in Texas and ranked 1st with the lowest affordable within the UT System (see Tables 1 and 2 below).
