

## UTRGV's Fall 2021 Enrollment in Perspective

Data from THECB's online accountability system at <http://www.txhigheredaccountability.org/acctpublic/> was used to look at UTRGV's total enrollment and Hispanic enrollment as compared to other 4-yr public universities in Texas and within the UT System.

- UTRGV's enrollment of **31,718** students in Fall 2021 makes it the 9<sup>th</sup> largest 4-year public university in Texas and 4<sup>th</sup> largest within the UT System (see Tables 1 and 2 below).
- UTRGV has the highest Hispanic enrollment (**31,718 students**) among all 4-yr public universities in Texas (see Table 3 on next page).
