

## UTRGV's Fall 2017 FTE Enrollment in Perspective

Data from THECB's online accountability system at <http://www.txhigheredaccountability.org/acctpublic/> was used to look at UTRGV's total FTE enrollment as compared to other 4-yr public universities in Texas and within the UT System.

- UTRGV's FTE enrollment of 22,324 students in Fall 2017 makes it the 10<sup>th</sup> largest 4-year public university in Texas and 5<sup>th</sup> largest within the UT System (see Tables 1 and 2 below).
- Table 3 presents the FTE ranking for all 4-yr public universities in Texas.
