

UTRGV's Fall 2019 Enrollment in Perspective

Data from THECB's online accountability system at <http://www.txhigheredaccountability.org/acctpublic/> was used to look at UTRGV's total enrollment and Hispanic enrollment as compared to other 4-yr public universities in Texas and within the UT System.

- UTRGV's enrollment of **28,909** students in Fall 2019 makes it the 10th largest 4-year public university in Texas and 5th largest within the UT System (see Tables 1 and 2 below).
- UTRGV has the highest Hispanic enrollment (**25,943 students**) among all 4-yr public universities in Texas (see Table 3 on next page).
