UTRGV's Fall 2015 FTE Enrollment in Perspective

Data from THECB's online accountability system at

<u>http://www.txhighereddata.org/Interactive/Accountability/</u> was used to look at UTRGV's total FTE enrollment as compared to other 4-yr public universities in Texas and within the UT System.

- UTRGV's FTE enrollment of 21,724 students in Fall 2015 makes it the 9th largest 4-year public university in Texas and 4th largest within the UT System (see Tables 1 and 2 below).
- Table 3 presents the FTE ranking for all 4-yr public universities in Texas.
