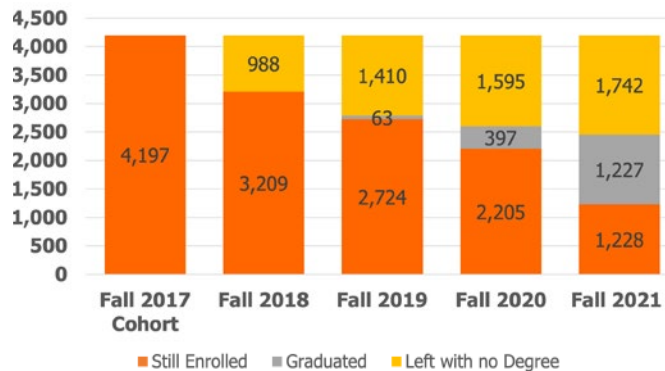


# RETENTION *Fall 2017 to Fall 2021*

## First-time Freshmen



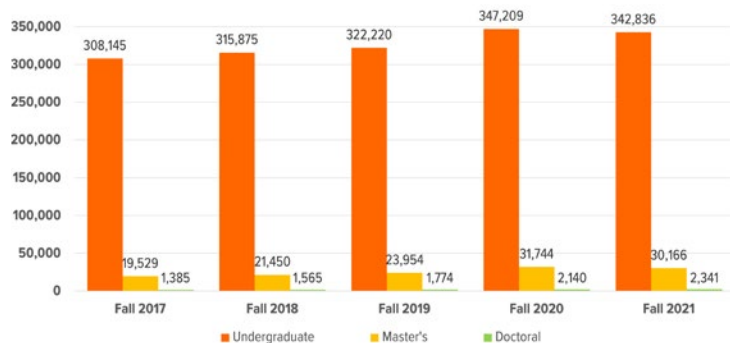
