The RealMD Certificate Program

The purpose of the RealMD Program is to promote a connection to one's highest purpose in medicine. Each year, students are eligible to earn a certificate for their engagement with the RealMD program. The point of the certificate is not to earn a certificate but to encourage learners to engage in activities which promote a deeper sense of professional meaning, community, and purpose. This program is opt-in, and it is your choice to participate.

MS1 Certificate Criteria

For the MS1 year, students have opportunities to participate in RealMD activities. The purpose of the point system is to allow students to create their own paths towards engagement with the program. When you have reached 100 points, you are eligible to receive a RealMD certificate for that year. At the end of the MS1 year, if you have engaged in activities that sum up to 100 points, document this below and email the form to realmd@utrgv.edu. The activities are below:
