_____ **Submission of Official Transcripts from all Colleges and Universities:** All official transcripts must be received by **July 1, 2027**, and can be submitted in one of two ways—electronically or by mail—to the addresses listed below. To be considered official, transcripts must be sent directly from the issuing institution and must include the date and degree conferred.

_____ **Submission of a Criminal Background Check:** You are responsible for obtaining a criminal background check (CBC) through to DISA Healthcare Technology. You will be asked to complete this national criminal background check no sooner than **March 01, 2027**, and no later than **July 01, 2027**. Regardless of any information disclosed during the admissions process, admission is contingent upon receiving a CBC showing no felony convictions and/or other serious violations described under "Other Requirements" within the [SOPM Application Requirements](#).

_____ **Submission of a Drug Screen:** You are responsible for obtaining a drug screening through DISA Healthcare. You will be asked to complete this screening no later than **30 days before the first day of Orientation**. All accepted students must have a negative urine drug result.

_____ **Satisfaction of all Immunization Requirements:** You are responsible for submitting all required immunizations as found in the [SOPM Student Handbook](#). Proof of immunizations signed by an authorized health care provider must be uploaded to your CastleBranch account. Documents must be in English and include your full name, date of birth, UTRGV student ID, medical school level (PMS1), and your graduation class (Class of 2031). This must be done no later than 30 days before the first day of Orientation.
