Fiscal Year 2024 Student Service Fee Projections

For FY2024, based on anticipated enrollment, the Office of Planning & Analysis projects \$3,862,912 in Student Service Fee revenue collection. The committee's recommendations for funding of budget proposals were based on the projected revenue.

Several departments were invited to present or provide additional information about the number of students served and assessment of impact/benefit to students. The committee deeply valued the variety of programs, events, and services represented by the requests for funds and have recommended allocations to help the units maintain these opportunities for student involvement, community engagement, experiential learning, and funding administrative operations and support services.

Due to limitations in available funding, not all requests were able to be awarded or fully funded as proposed. The final recommendations are based on the majority vote of the members.

The SFAC recommends allocating the available projected revenue of \$3,862,912 for FY 2024 and an additional \$81,413 from the reserve balance to continue pilot programs funded in FY2023.

Due to limited funding, the following proposals were not recommended for funding in FY24:

- UTRGV TexPrep
 - The TexPrep grant supports the summer program. The request for student services fee funding for student wages to supplement the program's budget is a valuable student employment opportunity. The committee recommends hiring work study eligible student employees to aid to help with the camp.
- Behavior Intervention Team
 - Existing funds may assist in providing training for team members. A proposal to expand training and certification and BIT outreach can be submitted in the future.

The following proposals were determined to be closely aligned to regularly scheduled academic functions of the departments/programs and are therefore ineligible for funding from student services fees:

- Music Technology Outreach Club
- Nursing Student Ambassador Program
- Social Work Field Placement
- Vackar Connection
