ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

The committee carefully considered each funding request for FY2017, but due to limited funding, all requests could not be fully funded. Funding requests are evaluated on various factors such as quality of service, number of students served, availability of other funding for program/service and overall benefit to students. Final recommendations are the result of a majority vote and reflect the committee's commitment to keep the best interest of UTRGV students at the forefront.

- Athletics: The committee recommends reducing the allocation to Athletics by \$294,896 (~3%) in order to fund student activities supported by the committee. The amount recommended represents 65% of the total allocation of student service fee funding initially distributed for FY17. The FY16 budget for Athletics was increased by over \$3 million from FY15; therefore, the committee felt the department could find 3% in savings (or increase revenue) to continue to meet departmental goals and objectives.
- Shuttle Services: The committee supports an expansion of shuttle services for UTRGV and recommends an increase of \$159,500 to the annual budget plus \$210,000 in one-time funding from Student Service Fees. Due to limited funding, the total amount requested was not approved, but the committee recommends the university provide additional support to provide the expansion of shuttle services outlined in their FY17 proposal. In addition, the department indicated that UTRGV is estimated to receive ~\$366,536 for eligible expenses from Valley Metro as a match. This may reduce the overall funds required.
- <u>Cheerleaders</u>: The committee recommends an increase of \$23,128 to cover annual expenses associated with attending the WAC tournament and recommends that cost savings be explored such as possibly traveling by bus like the Pep Band.
- Radio: The committee did not recommend continued funding for Radio since it is not currently broadcasting and due to minimal students using service.
- Hauser Communication Research Lab: The committee recommends to partially fund the Hauser Communication Research Lab with \$15,400 to provide administrative support to assist the program with marketing and scheduling of services. Strong communication skills are critical to student success; therefore, the committee highly recommends for the program to collaborate with Career Services to expand service opportunities and to help promote current services.
