#### **FY2018 STUDENT SERVICE FEE PROJECTION**

For FY2018, the Office of Planning & Analysis projects \$12,358,626 in Student Service Fee revenue collection. An estimated reduction in the amount of \$564,098 from FY2017 budgets would be needed to attain a balanced FY2018 budget.

# **ONE-TIME STUDENT SERVICE FEE FUNDING REQUESTS**

The committee supports the need of a parking and transportation study/service plan to benefit the shuttle services provided by UTRGV to students, faculty, and staff. However, in view of the projected reduction of collections in student service fee for FY2018, the committee recommends for the university to consider funding the \$120,000 Shuttle Services request.

## **COMMENTS**

The committee carefully considered each funding request for FY2018, but due to the reduction in student service fees, not all requests could be fully funded. Departments were invited to present on the quality of service, number of students served, availability of other funding for activity/service and overall benefit of the students. Final recommendations are the result of a majority vote and reflect the committee's commitment to keep the best interest of UTRGV students at the forefront.

- Athletics: The committee recommends reducing the allocation to Athletics by \$741,898.62 in order to balance the budget and fund other student activities supported by the committee. The amount recommended represents 63% of the total allocation of student service fee funding projected for FY2018. The committee is concerned about the proportion of fees allocated to Athletics in comparison to other student programs/activities.
- <u>Sexual Health & Alcohol Awareness</u>: The committee supports the splitting of funds from one project to two to better record the transactions for this activity.
- Pep Band: A recommended increase of \$27,073.89 was approved to support the Pep Band's travel expenses to the WAC Tournament. Funding has historically been approved as one-time funding and the committee supports for it to be a budgeted permanent request.
- <u>UTRGV Opera</u>: The committee recommends the continuation of \$5,000 to be allocated for UTRGV operatic productions. Funding for UTRGV Opera was approved as one-time funding in the past and performances have been successful.
- Hauser Communication Research Lab: The committee recommends to fund the Hauser Communication Research Lab with \$34,300, an increase of \$18,900 from FY2017, to market their services to students and expand their hours of operations. The committee believes that strong communication skills are critical to student success.
- Newspaper: The committee recommends a decrease of \$2,956.00 to Newspaper. The student newspaper generates some revenue from their advertising services; therefore, the committee felt the activity could generate additional revenue to supplement this reduction.
- Magazine: The committee recommends a reduction of \$10,790 in operating funds for Pulse
  Magazine in an attempt to be consistent on their funding recommendations to UTRGV printed
  magazines.
- <u>Student Activities and Student Involvement</u>: The committee supports the shifting of funding among these projects for budgetary purposes that was requested by department.
- <u>Chess</u>: The committee recommends an increase of \$16,880.36 to fully fund administrative and traveling costs, in addition to increases in scholarships as a result of tuition increases.
