 - Challenges: may not have all specialties represented, appointment structure in Handshake can remain the same or change
- Change to complete any 3 Careers in Medicine activity per academic year but 2 need to be career advising? (appointment, event, presentation, assessments, student interest events that are tracked in Handshake) -we create a menu (subcommittees assist with menu)
- Possible issues: tracking (how to consolidate data from multiple sources); 1 menu vs separate menus per year?
- What do we need: Final menu of activities, market to new class of 2026, available on Blackboard

- Students like the idea of the Core Career Advisors team
