

PGY-4 Rotation Descriptions

Female Pelvic Medicine & Reconstructive Surgery (FPMRS)

The rotation consists of 1 month spent learning FPMRS on the urology service. The goals of the rotation are: to build on previously attained gynecologic surgery skills, increase skills in perioperative care, deepen knowledge of pelvic anatomy, advance pelvic exam skills, and further generalist-level gynecologic skills in assessment and management of pelvic organ prolapse, urinary and fecal incontinence, pelvic pain, and related conditions.

Clinic/Outreach

This 3-month rotation provides the resident with a capstone experience in outpatient obstetrics, gynecology, and women's health, with focus on perioperative management, clinic leadership, medical education, and community outreach.

Gynecologic Oncology (DHR)

This rotation consists of approximately 1 month spent on the gynecologic oncology service. The goals of the rotation are to: build on previously attained gynecologic surgery skills, build on basic training in the foundations of robotic surgery, increase skills in perioperative care and advanced medicine (including nutritional therapy and pain management/palliative care), advance knowledge of anatomy, advance pelvic exam skills, and complete ACGME minimum procedure numbers in invasive cancer surgery.

Gynecology

This three-month rotation aims to provide the resident with a culminating experience in benign gynecology, with a focus on minimally invasive gynecology (including robotic surgery), advanced gynecologic surgery, solidification of basic surgical skills, perioperative management & case selection, perioperative & intraoperative teaching, and the leadership/management of a gynecologic care team.

Obstetrics Days Chief Resident (OB-D)

This capstone rotation allows the resident to revisit leadership of the obstetrics team, honing leadership, management, and teaching skills while gaining additional experience in advanced obstetric procedures and care planning for complex obstetric patients.

This two-week to one-month rotation will provide the resident with experience in key components of private and professional practice. Clinically, the resident will gain advanced experience in outpatient gynecology, with an emphasis on office procedures. Professionally, the resident will complete assigned readings and have targeted experiences related to patient safety, ethical practice, business and practice management, career planning, and personal physician finance.
