An applicant invited to interview for a resident/fellow position must be informed, in writing or by electronic means, of the terms, conditions and benefits of appointment to the ACGME-accredited program, either in effect at the time of the interview or that will be in effect at the time of his/her eventual appointment.

Information that is provided must include: financial support, vacations, parental, sick and other leaves of absence, and professional liability, hospitalization, health, disability and other insurance accessible to residents/fellows and their eligible dependents.
