ELPS
Objective The students will describe and explain how individuals have changed our community in the past and present.

Purpose/Focus

We will have a discussion on the different people who have changed their life. Who is a hero to you?

Direct Teach

The teacher will show a media piece of an important person in our community. Using a graphic organizer we will develop ideas of the hero we will focus on which is Cesar Chavez. The graphic organizer will have details on event he was part of.

Teacher will have a list of different people who influenced in the community and will randomly give the bilingual groups an assigned one.
