#### **Discussion:**

Carla asked about Employee Picnics and other similar activities. School of Medicine Harlingen Campus is on many occasions left out of announcements, etc. For example, UTRGV recently held a "best week ever" event in which the Brownsville and Edinburg Campuses were mentioned as sites that would have refreshments and promo items.
