1) Call to Order

4) Reports / Guest Presentations

4.1 UTRGV Sports Medicine & Concussion Protocols — Dr. Aamir Ahmad (with Dr. Bob Schenck)

- Introductions and background; expansion of sports medicine and fellowship leadership.
- Coverage plan: multiple physicians at all home games; travel coverage for road games.

- Concussion management: NCAA D-I protocol; baseline testing for all athletes; trained sideline team; medical spotter halts play for suspected head/neck injuries; return-to-play only after protocol milestones are met.
- Outlook (5–10 years): build premier sports medicine program in Texas; launch Ambulatory Surgery Center; expand research, fellows, and national profile.

4.2 Athletics / Football Program Updates — Chasse Conque & Coach Travis Bush

- Training camp begins July 30–31; ~25 practices leading to the Aug 30 season opener.
- Camp practices on campus (generally closed to public); potential limited public activity depending on stadium construction.
- Culture & success metrics: focus on daily improvement, academics, community engagement; wins expected to follow culture.
- **Recruiting:** balance roster with upperclassmen; continue recruiting the Valley; camps held and strong local HS engagement.
- **NIL:** compete appropriately at FCS level; steward donor/corporate support; recruit studentathletes who value education & competition.
- Community/Staff support: keep excitement high; continued campus partnership is essential.

Key Operations & Ticketing Notes (Athletics)

- Aug 1: major game-day information push.
- rallythevalley.com becomes game-day central (parking, tailgating, themes, tickets).
- Stadium: capacity near 12,000 with added south-end seating; 25% reserved for students.
- Season tickets & premium seating: sold out (multi-year for suites/club).
- Single-game inventory: possible limited Friday releases from unused visiting-team allotments.
- Students: claim tickets weekly (Mon–Fri) for Saturday games.
- Homecoming: October 25.
- Athletics notes ~400–500 staff working each home game; broad campus collaboration.

4.3 School of Optometry — Dean William Miller

Background and team building; networking with local optometrists/ophthalmologists.

- Accreditation timeline: Stage 1 achieved; Stage 2 Feb 2026 (decision ~May); site visit within six months; first class Fall 2027.
- Cohort & hiring: 40 students per class; plan to hire ~21 faculty plus administrators.
- Clinic & site: intent to house school & public clinic at the McAllen Monitor Building (Jackson Ave.) with ~22–25 exam rooms; integrate UT Health RGV Vision Center under school umbrella.
- **Curriculum:** team-based learning; robust board-prep; emphasis on community health (diabetes, hypertension, low vision, sports vision).
- **Tuition:** state-competitive (lower than UIW; slightly lower than UH; aligned with SOM/School of Podiatric Medicine).
- Workforce need: Valley has fewer optometrists per capita vs. Texas; goal to keep grads local.
- Q&A highlights:
 - Halos after cataract surgery: can be edema-related (often resolves) or lens-related (may persist; follow up with surgeon if prolonged).
 - Floaters: unrelated to contact lens wear; typical age-related vitreous changes; monitor as indicated.
