## Participant Agreement

**Please read, sign, and submit the participant agreement form to your respective advisor.**

As a participant, I fully understand that my conduct is a direct reflection of the University and that I am required to abide by federal, state and local laws and am subject to all University policies, rules, and regulations while serving as a participant.

### GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

All students, whether regularly-enrolled, full-time or part-time, or non-University students participating in University-sponsored programs, are expected and required to comply with the Student Conduct and Discipline (STU 02-100) policy to observe standards of conduct appropriate for an academic institution. The following practices are considered unacceptable conduct for members of the University community but not limited to:

1. Illegal use, possession, and/or sale of a drug, narcotic, or paraphernalia at the University *[or, by extension, while on a university-sponsored or endorsed event]* is prohibited.
2. Computer usage violations, use of alcoholic beverages, dishonesty, gambling, defacing of property, endangering the health or safety of others, use of abusive or vulgar language, altering of records, possession or use of firearms, failure to respond promptly to official notices, etc., will subject the student to disciplinary action.
3. Conduct that endangers, or verbal or written threats to, the health or safety of any person on the campus of the University or on any property, or in any building, or facility owned or controlled by the U.T. System or in attendance at any University-sponsored or University-supervised function is prohibited.
4. Inappropriate behavior for members of an academic institution (such conduct includes but is not limited to gambling, the excessive use of intoxicating liquors, public nudity, harassing phone calls or e-mail, and berating or otherwise abusive behavior.)

### STAYING WITH THE GROUP

Students must abide by travel itinerary and be on time at designated pick up locations. It is expected that participants remain with the group and follow the scheduled itinerary for the day. Any participant traveling to the retreat with the University, must return to the university with the group. Chaperones may advise student participants of curfew times.

## COURTESY TO ROOMMATES, HOTEL GUESTS, AND EMPLOYEES

Students must sleep in the rooms assigned to them. Courtesy to roommates is required. Conflict with roommates should be reported to a university advisor and/or trip coordinator. A sensible effort to get enough sleep must be supported by all roommates. All participants will be required to be in their respective rooms by \_\_\_\_\_.

## SOCIALIZING

Behavior must remain within the standards of appropriate and acceptable conduct as a representative of the university. Harassment, discrimination, sexual misconduct, or behavior that contributes to creating a hostile environment for participants is unacceptable.

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I understand and agree that I may be subject to sanctions for failure to comply with state and federal laws and the rules and regulations regarding student conduct both while on-campus and while traveling with the University. Possible sanctions may be imposed by the Dean of Students in conjunction with the approved disciplinary procedures including, but not limited to: warning, disciplinary probation, withholding of grades, official transcript or degree, restitution, failing grade, denial of degree, suspension and expulsion, or revocation of degree and withdrawal of diploma. In addition, certain privileges may be withdrawn consistent with the severity of the offense. These penalties may be imposed singularly or in any combination upon individuals, groups or organizations.
