GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

All students, whether regularly-enrolled, full-time or part-time, or non-University students participating in University-sponsored programs, are expected and required to comply with the Student Conduct and Discipline (STU 02-100) policy to observe standards of conduct appropriate for an academic institution. The following practices are considered unacceptable conduct for members of the University community but not limited to:

- 1. Illegal use, possession, and/or sale of a drug, narcotic, or paraphernalia at the University [or, by extension, while on a university-sponsored or endorsed event] is prohibited.
- 2. Computer usage violations, use of alcoholic beverages, dishonesty, gambling, defacing of property, endangering the health or safety of others, use of abusive or vulgar language, altering of records, possession or use of firearms, failure to respond promptly to official notices, etc., will subject the student to disciplinary action.
- 3. Conduct that endangers, or verbal or written threats to, the health or safety of any person on the campus of the University or on any property, or in any building, or facility owned or controlled by the U.T. System or in attendance at any University-sponsored or University-supervised function is prohibited.
- 4. Inappropriate behavior for members of an academic institution (such conduct includes but is not limited to gambling, the excessive use of intoxicating liquors, public nudity, harassing phone calls or e-mail, and berating or otherwise abusive behavior.)
