Students placed in **SPAN 2313** will follow **TRACK 1** (orange). They will complete all the courses in white + those labeled as "TRACK 1" (highlighted in orange).

Students placed in **SPAN 2315** will follow **TRACK 2** (yellow). They will complete all the courses in white + those labeled as "TRACK 2" (highlighted in yellow).

Students placed in **SPAN 3313** will follow **TRACK 3** (blue). They will complete all the courses in white + those labeled as "TRACK 3" (highlighted in blue).
