

Student Participation Agreement

TRiO SSS is designed to assist participants with enhancing their academic skills in a welcoming atmosphere where they can thrive intellectually, personally, and professionally. An active participant is expected to complete **any three activities from the following categories (per semester):**

Mentoring and Advising:

- Meet with TRiO SSS professional staff member
- Meet with Peer Coach Assistant (support session)
- Meet with Student Success Assistant (support session)
- Meet with Academic Success Tutor (tutoring session)

Academic/Social/Support Activities:

- Attend support service: FAFSA, scholarships, mental health, withdrawing and registration, etc.
- Attend educational program: *financial/economic literacy, book club, study day/night, etc.*
- Attend social: meet & greet, game night, celebrations, etc.
- Attend educational experience: *excursion, trip, conference, etc.*
- Attend Peer Coach Assistant, Student Success Assistant, and/or Academic Success Tutor presentation
- Attend conference: Academic Preparedness & Readiness, College Survival, Life Skills & Adulting
- Referral and utilization of campus resource: Writing Center, Learning Center, University Library, Counseling Center, Food Pantry, Student Health, etc.

Excursions to UTRGV/Local Events:

- UTRGV-sponsored event
- Cultural event
- Volunteer event
- Student organization involvement fair
- Graduate fair
- Career fair

Other:

- Complete the end of semester/year survey
- Submit the progress report by the designated deadline each semester

We may also consider points earned by visiting our office to study, using the computer lab, obtaining a resource (scantron, headphone, printing, calculator, academic supplies), or needing general assistance. Some points are weighed more heavily when determining grant aid recipients, travel opportunities, etc.
