TEXAS Grant Renewal Requirements

Congrabulations on your TEXAS Grant award! in addition to meeting the general program requirements (financial need, enrolled at least 9 hours, etc.), you must meet the following TEXAS Grant Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements to ensure you keep your TEXAS Grant for the upcoming years.

TEXAS Grant Academic Renewal Requirements

At the end of the first academic year, a student must meet the following UTRGV SAP Requirements:

- Have a minimum GPA of a 2.00
- Pass 67% of all attempted courses

At the end of the second year, and all subsequent years, students must complete the following:

- have a minimum 2.5 overall institutional GPA.
- completed and passed 24 SCHs. (Repeat classes that were previously passed with a grade of "0" or better do not count as new earned hours)

If requirements are not met after the Spring term, a student has the opportunity to regain their eligibility in the Summer. Eligibility will be reviewed again at the end of the Summer II term.

TEXAS Grant Maximum Time Frame:

Eligibility ends when one of the following has been met, whichever comes first:

- 5 years pass from the start of the semester in which the student received the first award (3 years if student was initially awarded based on an associate's degree) if in a degree plan of 4 years or less; or
- 150 overall attempted hours
- 150 credit hours paid by the program (90 credit hours if student was initially awarded based on an associatic's degree) while receiving grant funds; or
- Earn a baccalaureale degree

TEXAS Grant Appeals:

Students not meeting the eligibility requirements by the end of the academic year and have experienced a hardship may complete and submit the TEXAS Grant Appeal form. TEXAS Grant Appeals may be found at www.utrgv.edu/appeals.

Important Notice. Meeting all eligibility requirements is not a guarantee that you will receive a continuation award through the TEXAS Grant program. Funding is limited and receiving an award is contingent on funding availability.
