



# THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS RIO GRANDE VALLEY AND TEXAS SOUTHMOST COLLEGE

Articulation Agreement
Associate of Arts in Business Administration (TSC)
Bachelor of Business Administration (UTRGV)

This AGREEMENT, effective the 1st day of January 2020, is between The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley ("UTRGV"), a component institution of The University of Texas System, and Texas Southmost College ("TSC"), a College having its principal office in Brownsville, Texas.

WHEREAS, UTRGV and TSC desire to implement an Articulation to provide students enrolled at TSC with an opportunity to smoothly transition to and further their educational opportunity at UTRGV.

WHEREAS, students declaring Business Administration as their major at TSC and successfully completing the courses outlined below is an indicator to UTRGV that the student has completed the appropriate courses, received the necessary instructions and preparation, and that similar knowledge, skills, and student learning outcomes can be expected, enabling the student's progression to the upper division course sequence or requirement at UTRGV.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein, the parties agree to the following:

#### I. Term

This agreement shall be effective for three years from the date of its execution, upon revisions mandated by state requirements, or until a new agreement is created. The agreement may be renewed upon the mutual written approval of The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley and Texas Southmost College.

#### 2. Courses of Study

UTRGV's Robert C. Vackar College of Business & Entrepreneurship (VCOBE) will accept the complete set of lower division courses from a student who successfully completes courses outlined below from TSC and is admitted to UTRGV.

- All TSC courses transferred to UTRGV shall be part of the Lower Division Academic Course Guide Manual issued by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.
- For the UTRGV Bachelor of Business Administration, the following Core Curriculum Courses will satisfy degree requirements as follows:

- If BCIS 1305 was taken after fall 2019, it will count as INFS 2300 Data Management Modeling Tools. If BCIS was taken before fall 2019, it will count as INFS 1001 Computer Proficiency.
- In accordance with Sec 61.822 of the Texas Education Code, a student who successfully completes 2.1. courses in the TSC core curriculum will receive academic credit at UTRGV for each of the core courses transferred. However, there are circumstances where additional classes are required by the major even when core is complete.
- Transfer students must apply for admission and meet requirements to UTRGV and VCOBE. 2.2. UTRGV requires a GPA of 2.6 as well as earned grade of C or better in ECON 2301, ECON 2302. ACCT 2301, ACCT 2302, MGMT 1301, and QUMT 2341 or their TSC equivalents to be admitted into VCOBE. Transfer students are encouraged to complete their Associate of Arts in Business Administration at TSC prior to completion of their first semester of study at UTRGV. TSC and UTRGV faculty will work with students to help promote the completion of the Associates degree in a timely fashion.
- 2.3. This Articulation Agreement will be published and provided as a transfer guide during academic advisement at TSC.
